1. Welcome/Introductions

- a. Secretary Jamie Clyde excused absence due date change and previous conflict.

2. Principal Eaton Update

- a. School Board nomination process changing. Instead of voting in new candidates, candidates will be asked to submit their name and short paragraph/resume of why they want to be on the Board. Father Larry and Father Adam along with Principal Eaton will discern who will be accepted based on the Board's upcoming needs. Two seats are open this year for a three year term each.
- b. 119 children currently enrolled – strong numbers.
