1. Welcome/Call to Order/Opening Prayer

2. Capital Campaign Presentation - Ryan Schon along with Frs. Larry Hoffmann and Adam Westphal presented on the capital campaign, sharing on the parish's history and showing a short video on the plans for expansion. Questions were addressed regarding the specific school expansion, financial requirements and estimated timelines.

Jayna Beal inquired about FSA contributing to the campaign and it was decided that the executive committee will look into finances to see the potential for giving as well as what it would mean for long term giving and for future campaigns.

3. Treasurer's Report - no updates from Jenifer Mulcahy on April activity, but we did acquire the can rack for the kitchen for a discount as well as batons for the track team. Executive committee is meeting with Mrs. Eaton in June to review next year's budget.

4. Old Business

a. Upcoming Events: Teacher Appreciation Week is this week. Flowers were given on Monday, water bottles with candy on Tuesday, Wednesday is provided by the parents. FSA is providing Panera for breakfast on Thursday and Latin King for lunch on Friday. Knights are also hosting a teacher pizza dinner on Wednesday. In addition to teacher appreciation week the executive committee will look into organizing a way to help with room setup prior to the school year opening as an additional way of showing our support and appreciation for our teachers.

b. Spirit Wear Update - initial designs are in and feedback provided. We are working with the company and Mrs. Eaton on finalizing colors and rolling out the website.

a. School Board Update was provided by Anna Schaffer. 39 students have registered kindergarten next year so far. The current total

registered for school is 154 for next year. School Board is in the process of updating teacher and student handbooks. Some new teachers have been hired and will be announced soon by Mrs. Eaton. Open school board positions will be announced soon as well. Additionally, the School Board will soon be revealing a 10 year school plan.
