

Monday, October 1st FSA Meeting

The meeting was called to order by FSA President, Chrissy Eberhart and opened with a prayer.

Mrs. Eaton provided a brief update regarding current school activities. 2 new students started this month so our total enrollment is at 162. St. Luke's Parish will be celebrating Oxtoberfest on Saturday, October 20th and as a school we would like to participate through volunteering with the event as well as providing baked goods for a bake sale. More information on this will be coming home with students and a portion of the Oxtoberfest proceeds will be used for school, so we would love to have great representation from our school families! St. Luke's will also be implementing the Whole Life Curriculum into the school day, which teaches our children respect for life at all stages.

FSA was visited by our 4th grade teacher, Ms. Pollpeter and the school Guidance Counselor Ms. Fischer. Both teachers began by thanking the FSA for the \$200 start up money that was provided to all teachers at the beginning of the school year, it was greatly appreciated. Ms. Pollpeter discussed her 4th grade book club program that is used for their reading class to help engage students and give them ownership of different topic areas. Ms. Fischer discussed how she is currently working with students on topics such as feelings and building relationships while also working with Mrs. Eaton on building out a guidance program that will encompass K through 8th grades.

Treasurer's Report: current account balance is \$29,907.39. This does not reflect the \$10,000 requested by the school board, which will be utilized for additional training and travel expenses for the principal and staff to occur later this year. The FSA Treasurer and Executive board are working with the finance council, Fr. Adam and Mrs. Eaton on future year budgets to clearly identify the line items FSA fundraisers plan to address.

Old Business

Green ParTee: 62 golfers have registered for the event on Saturday, October 6th. An estimated \$2,000 has been raised through sponsorships and additional funds are expected through cash games available throughout the day and course.

Green Gala: meetings have commenced, and the committee is currently seeking sponsors. The team is excited about new auction software that will be introduced this year that will assist in a more user-friendly experience.

Trunk or Treat: Information and flyers are being sent out about this event on October 26th. Signups are available for families interested in hosting a trunk. Prizes will be provided for the top 3 trunks and will be selected by attendee voting.

Teacher Conferences: will take place November 6th and 8th. FSA will cater one meal and ask parents to provide items for the second meal. A Sign-up Genius will be sent out closer to the date.
