

## **Monday, January 7th FSA Meeting**

The meeting was called to order by FSA Vice President, Jamie Clyde and opened with a prayer.

Principal Eaton announcements:

- Catholic Schools week will be kicked off on January 27<sup>th</sup>, with a student led mass that Sunday at 8:30am with activities happening all week for the students and teachers.
- Current registration numbers sit at 162 students
- The school board is in the process of reviewing next year's start date, which will be after August 23<sup>rd</sup> (per state law) and will align with other Catholic schools throughout the diocese.
- The Christmas program was a success, but with the change in venue came a learning curve! The Spring Program/Fine Arts night will be in the gym as well to accommodate size, but she is open for suggestions for organizing the event including the children's artwork.

Teacher Update:

- Mrs. Hotchkiss, one of our kindergarten teachers, visited the FSA meeting and shared a big thank you from her and all the teachers for the FSA's hard work and support, especially for the Green Gala dessert auction proceeds funding the ST Math program, which she has had much success in with her kindergarten class.
