1. **Welcome/Introductions** – Opening Prayer
2. **Principal Visit** – Provided by Principal Hade. We've had a great start to the year! FAST reading assessments are taking place for the older grades and benchmarks are being taken for the younger classes. For our first out of uniform day the school raised \$225 for Project Hope. Moving forward the students will be able to help select the causes that benefit from out of uniform donations. Meals from the Heartland meal packing is scheduled for October 8th. Lunch and playground volunteer schedules have been sent out and we are still working on filling some spots. We are still working on a Spanish solution, which may involve Mrs. Babcock and an after school solution.
3. **Financial Update** – Our current balance is about \$50,000. It was brought up by parents in attendance that next year for the FSA Teacher Start Up money we should look into utilizing Scrip cards and our Amazon link to gain additional rewards.
4. **Old Business**
 - a. **Green Par Tee Update:** The Green ParTee was a great success. We were able to raise about \$16,000.
 - b. **2019-20 Volunteer Forms:** Only about 40% completed and many classes are in need of homeroom parents. A reminder email will be sent out.

 - b. **School Board Update:** New members have been implemented. St. Luke's has been approved by the city as a school zone. David Neidergeses is leading the technology effort for the new building. The board is also implementing information on concussion protocols and adding that to the handbook. Father Ken has a goal of 60 new students next year, but budgeting will plan for 40. Over the next 5 years we hope to bring teacher pay to within 90% of public schools. The board is also looking at having tuition be a comprehensive number that would be all-inclusive of all fees. This would be beneficial for families seeking CTO assistance.
