    - i. Added that at the time of this meeting, zero teachers or students had tested positive for COVID-19 or needed to be quarantined.

    - i. Steve was at the Back to School/Picture/Supply Drop off day in the gym to talk to parents about the plan for extra-curricular activities this year. In talking to the parents they loved the layout and information and were happy to see a schedule set for the year. This enthusiasm was tempered somewhat as one of the talking points was that this was the schedule but we are postponing or canceling the programs set to take place in the fall.
